The EB House Austria consists of four units:

EB OUTPATIENT CLINIC: HELP

In the EB outpatient clinic, "butterfly children" receive medical care: Here, wound control and care, pain management, treatment of accompanying symptoms and preventive examinations take place. Affected and caring parents or relatives are given competent advice.

EB RESEARCH UNIT: UNDERSTANDING

The research team is dedicated to the alleviation and cure of EB. Here, research is being conducted with great commitment into healing options, effective wound treatment, and early detection and therapies for skin cancer. Forward-looking approaches give the "butterfly children" great hope for a life without blisters, wounds and pain.

EB ACADEMY: LEARNING

The EB Academy organizes training programs for medical professionals as well as seminars for people living with EB and relatives. The focus is on further education, exchange of professional experience and worldwide networking of experts.

EB STUDY CENTER: HEALING

The EB Study Center team is intensively dedicated to establishing the efficacy, tolerability and safety of new therapeutic approaches for EB. Clinical trials give patients access to innovative treatment options, even before they are approved and ensure medical progress in many ways.
